The Golden Retriever Foundation (GRF) and the Golden Retriever Club of America (GRCA) are excited about the new, groundbreaking research project being conducted by the Morris Animal Foundation to identify genetic, nutritional, and environmental risk factors for cancer and other canine diseases. This is the largest and longest study ever undertaken to improve the health of dogs. The project is known as the Golden Retriever Lifetime Study (GRLS) and was announced on the inside front cover of the Nov/Dec 2012 GRNews with links to more information.

GRCA and GRF have developed a special bulletin to breeders and a letter for breeders to provide their puppy buyers to inform and to encourage participation. These will be published in an upcoming issue of the Golden Retriever News and are attached as PDF files to this email message.



He exceeded all expectations. Wild, smart, tough and an excellent marker, even at 8 weeks. We worked at home on his early marking and obedience, but I realized early on that his talent put him in another league and I did not want to be responsible for blowing it! He went off to Jerry & Jane Patopea by 5 months of age and launched himself into his work.

I say work because he lives to train, whether it be marking birds, doing drills or just brushing up his obedience. He also can be quite a cuddlier (when Jerry is not watching). His favorite playmate, Mulligan (our other dog in training), is his counter in mahogany; sometimes they terrorize the kennel as they lap the field.

Lance transforms into the perfect soldier when we are training on tests or at a trial; he is the model of obedience and focus. He had a few bumps in training, but ended the trial season with 9 all-breed derby points, just

one shy of making the National Derby List. He is now focusing on polishing up his blinds so he can get back to work in the Qualifying stakes later this spring.

The Objectives of the Evergreen Golden Retriever Club
