WHEREAS it remains a goal of the GRCA to encourage and assist Golden Retriever rescue operations as a humane and charitable endeavor, and

WHEREAS GRCA seeks to ensure that rescues are operating safely and ethically in their communities, and

WHEREAS the National Rescue Committee is in need of restructuring.

RESOLUTION 20-16

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED to establish a task force to review the NRC and rescue practices, create standards for rescue groups to follow and make recommendations to the GRCA Board in accordance with the attached Job Description for the Golden Retriever Rescue Task Force.

GOLDEN RETRIEVER RESCUE TASK FORCE COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: To realign the missions of the Golden Retriever Club of America and the National Rescue Committee, review the current state of rescue, develop guidelines and make recommendations to the Board.

Ability to communicate in a timely manner via email and Dropbox and share documents as needed.

Review and revise the Job Description of the NRC and bring the committee structure into conformity with the standard format of GRCA committees.

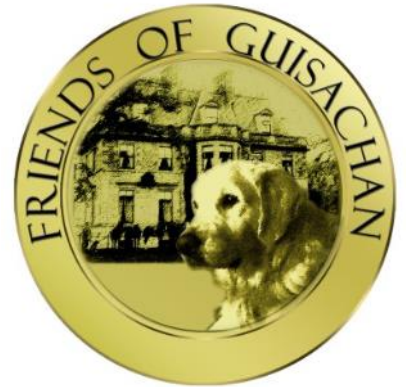
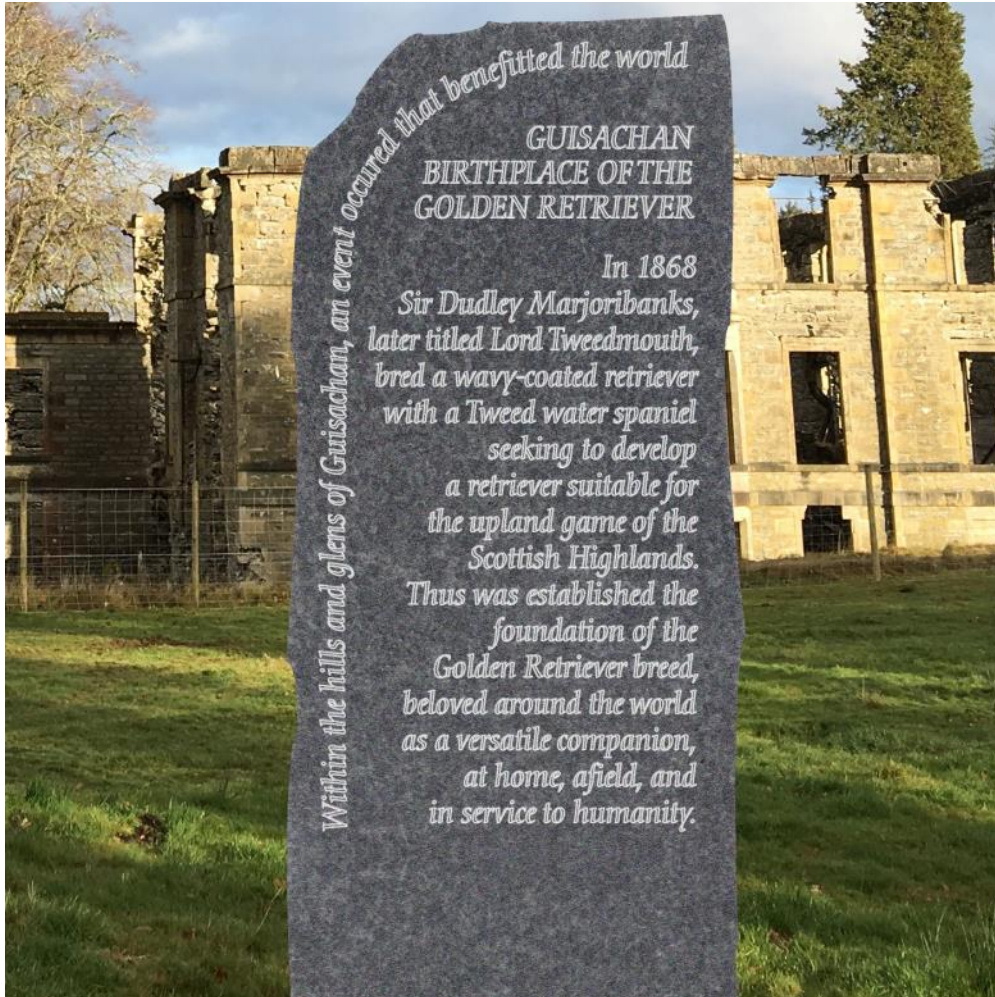
Define how Golden rescue groups are identified and approved for inclusion in the NRC.

Investigate importation practices and develop standards and guidelines that satisfy the concerns outlined in the GRCA's published importation policy. Guidelines will address the sources of dogs, veterinary standards to be used, quarantine procedures and capabilities of individual rescue groups, among a long list of other issues.

Establish a Review Board to mediate disputes and/or violations.
